

**RESOLUTION NO. 1433**

**A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE LOW-INCOME SENIOR  
OR DISABLED CITIZENS ELECTRIC DISCOUNT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, Public Utility District No. 2 of Pacific County first established a Low Income Senior Discount Program with adoption by the Board of Commissioners of Resolution No. 831 on February 19, 1980; and

WHEREAS, disabled citizens, eighteen years of age or older meeting the Washington State law definition of permanent disability, were added as an element under adoption of Resolution No. 1054; and

WHEREAS, the most recent amendment to the income levels of this District Program was made on December 19<sup>th</sup> of 2006 along with adoption of an annual adjustment process with passage of Resolution No. 1254; and

WHEREAS, a requirement for records submittal by new and recurring applicants on an annual basis with District review to determine meeting total household income levels and proper form submittal in order to participate in the Program was approved under Resolution No. 1180 on October 16, 2001; and

WHEREAS, further adjustments were deemed necessary and approved under Resolution No. 1362 on July 21, 2015; and

WHEREAS, clarification is required defining certain sections of the program and a formal policy created allowing the District to hold participants responsible if a change of status occurs or a fraudulent application has been received; and

WHEREAS, the District has added wording allowing the right to reserve discontinuation of the program for a year in which the amount to be distributed exceeds the allotted budget amount for the program; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Public Utility District No. 2 of Pacific County, Washington that participants are to meet a certain percentage of the Federal Poverty Level to receive a discount of 10-40% up to \$400 per year.

BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that new Program applicants will be required to include total household income/monies received by every household member and other supporting paperwork with the initial application and then each subsequent odd number calendar year for as long as they are involved in the Low-Income Senior or Disabled Citizens Discount Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all previous resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
