

RESOLUTION NO. 1448

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A
CLEAN ENERGY IMPLEMENTATION PLAN (CEIP)**

WHEREAS, the Clean Energy Transformation Act (CETA) was signed into Washington State law on May 7, 2019; and

WHEREAS, a requirement of CETA is that by January 1, 2022, and every four years thereafter, each electric utility must develop and submit a four-year clean energy implementation plan for the standards established under RCW 19.405.040 and 19.405.050 that proposes specific targets for energy efficiency, demand response, and renewable energy and proposed interim targets for meeting the standard under RCW 19.405.040 during the years prior to 2030 and between 2030 and 2045; and

WHEREAS, the Clean Energy Implementation Plan must be informed by the electric utility's clean energy action plan developed under RCW 19.280.030, be consistent with RCW 19.405.060, and identify specific actions to be taken by the electric utility over the next four years, consistent with the utility's long-range integrated resource plan and resource adequacy requirement, that demonstrate progress toward meeting the standards under RCW 19.405.040 and 19.405.050 and the abovementioned interim targets. The specific actions identified must be informed by the electric utility's historic performance under median water conditions and resource capability and by the electric utility's participation in centralized markets. In identifying specific actions in its clean energy implementation plan, the electric utility may also take into consideration any significant and unplanned loss or addition of load it experiences; and

NOW THEREFORE, the proposed Clean Energy Implementation Plan (CEIP) is adopted for submittal to the Department of Commerce by January 1, 2022.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all previous resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
