New Policies and Updates Adopted by Board

The District held public hearings during the month of March to adopt new policies along with the update of the Fee Schedule, Purchasing and Formal Bid Policy, and rates. New policies include an Electronic Signature policy authorizing the Board and other administrative staff members to use electronic signatures on District documents, a Cyber Security and Technology Use policy to help keep the District safe from cyber attacks and provide guidelines for staff when using District devices, and an Automatic Meter Technology Opt-Out Policy. This poli-

cy allows those in areas where automatic meters are installed to opt-out. Automatic Meter Technology assists the District in more efficiently reading meters and accessing data on a real time basis. The update to the District's Fee Schedule includes the addition of a one-time opt-out fee of \$165 for meters to be changed from automatic to manually read and a monthly fee of \$25 for meter readers to come to the location each month. Also, the District was informed that return envelopes are no longer available to order in a timely manner and therefore it was decided to discontinue providing them in billing statements. When available, they may be picked up at front counters.

Broadband Update

The District was awarded \$5M in grant funding for telecom projects in the Bay Center, Lynn Point, Wilson Point, and Nemah areas. This project will span over the course of two years. Customers in this area are encouraged to call Retail Service Providers (RSPs) for information regarding obtaining service. This information can be found on the PUD website at www.pacificpud.org/RSPs.html. The District has also applied for nearly \$19M in funding from the USDA Rural Development Broadband ReConnect Program to cover the areas of Brooklyn, Vesta, Smith Creek, Ward Creek, Elkhorn Road, Mallis Landing Road to South Fork, and South of South Bend on 101 to Wilson Point.

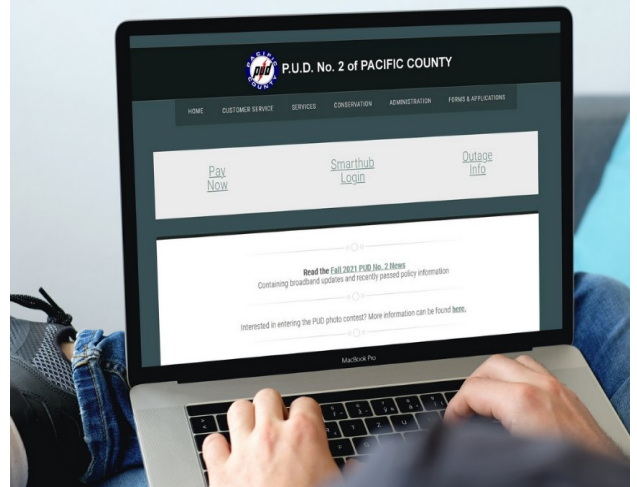
